Students and staff are engaging in learning with Ms. Belcher using a board purchased program called Minds Up, to teach students about social emotional wellness and well-being. Instruction occurs daily from Monday to Thursday, during the weeks of October 26 – 29, November 9 – 12, and November 23 – 26, and each learning session is approximately 45 minutes long. Both staff and students are enjoying learning about this very important topic under the guidance of Ms. Belcher.
